


# **Redhill Day Nursery**

Gong Hey Fat Choy! Last week we had lots of fun celebrating Chinese New Year. With 2018 being the Year of the Dog, the Babies decorated their display board to reflect this and the Toddlers and Preschool children joined in with mark making and shape matching activities. Throughout the nursery the children have had a whale of a time exploring textures and fine motor skills, using chopsticks with rice and noodle play. They also explored different ways of making marks, using wooden blocks to create Chinese writing. Lucky red envelopes are a lovely tradition centred around Chinese New Year and the children had lots of fun decorating their own lucky envelopes with gold glitter and sequins too.



















### **Room Updates...**





The Babies have had a whale of a time exploring with their senses throughout February and March. Some of the textures they enjoyed exploring included clean mud (tissue soap and water), porridge and cocoa powder and shaving foam. They loved using the Dabber pens to make and explore marks, along with painting on the table and rolling ball through paint. They also had lots of fun exploring the garden, throwing the ribbon balls and using the tubes to roll cars down (it was great fun to pretend the tubes were telescopes too!).























The Toddlers have had lots of fun exploring different ways of making marks throughout February and March. They loved making marks with vegetables, along with rolling cars through the paint and using stickle bricks to make marks in paint too. Sensory exploration was also a hit too with water play, sticky jelly play and helping to make the pancake mixture. They have also been developing their hand eye coordination with activities like cutting and threading too!





















Throughout February and March the Preschool children have been exploring cause and effect, and how combining different substances changes their properties. They looked on in amazement as they added watered down paint to milk and it made patterns. Making marks in a chalk/salt mixture and making a welly boot rainbow were also a huge hit too! With the snow days fast approaching the children had lots of fun exploring how ice had formed in the garden, pointing out that it was 'crispy' under their boots and smooth when they touched it.
