As always they have loved indulging in some extremely messy activities, including shaving foam and jelly and painting with marsh mallows and coloured icing sugar! We have been encouraging the babies that are gaining strength on their feet to explore their

surroundings with the walkers, with some great success. The babies in Ruby room have also shown a real interest in the dollies this month, so we took note and encouraged them to explore water play at the same time by giving all of the dollies a bath!!











This month Emerald room have enjoyed exploring the marks they make in a variety of ways!! These have included finger painting with coloured icing sugar, painting with stickle bricks and moving their fingers through cooked spaghetti and custard. With St Patricks Day on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March, the children also enjoyed exploring textures with lime and orange jelly mixed with marshmallow fluff

to celebrate the colours of the Irish flag. Lots of the children have developed an interest in fine motor skill activities like cutting, threading, and sifting and transferring things like rice and pasta. To support this new interest the staff in the toddler room have been encouraging the children to practice their cutting skills with catalogues and magazines. As Easter approaches the children in the toddler room have also enjoyed lots of collaging and painting as part of their Easter window display, along with creating clay decorations to decorate the Easter tree situated in the toddler room window. # Please remember that the Nursery is closed on Good Friday and Easter Monday.


