- Recipe • 120g Gluten free Plain Flour
- 120g Pure life butter
- 120g Vegan Cheddar Cheese

Holiday discount:

Entitlement to holiday discount applies to children after the child has attended for 3 full calendar months. However, once a child is in receipt of funded hours at Redhill Day Nursery, no holiday discount will be applied.

- Holiday discount of 50% is allowed for the equivalent of two weeks holiday each calendar year (January to December). On a pro-rata basis.
- The holiday discount will be deducted from the appropriate monthly invoice and therefore six weeks written notice of holiday dates is required.
- Should your child's attendance change within the year the holiday discount entitlement will be adjusted accordingly. Any resulting underpayment of fees will be recovered on the next or final invoice.
- Full fees will be charged for any other absence.
- Please note, that if you are in receipt of full-time discount no further discounts can be applied

If your personal details have changed recently i.e. new number or new address please let us know ASAP. It is vital we hold up to deta information for all contacts involving your

date information for all contacts involving your child. In the event of an emergency we must ensure we have the relevant numbers we need. We have also noticed that some Blossom 'all about me' are currently out of date please could you use your app to update your child's information so the staff have up to date knowledge about your child.
